1.0 Introduction

The Government of Kenya has received financing from the World Bank towards the financing of the Kenya Off-Grid Solar Access Project for underserved counties (K-OSAP). The project covers a period of six years. The project development objective is to increase access to modern energy services in underserved counties of Kenya. The project will be implemented in 14 counties, namely:- Garissa, Isiolo, Kilifi, Kwale, Lamu, Mandera, Marsabit, Narok, Samburu, Taita Taveta, Tana River, Turkana, Wajir and West Pokot . The Project will be implemented by the Ministry of Energy, Kenya Power and Lighting Company (KPLC) and Rural Electrification Authority (REA).

2.0 Project Components

The Project comprises the following components:

- Electrification of households, public facilities and businesses through mini-grid systems;
- Electrification of households through standalone solar systems and provision of clean cooking solutions for house-holds;
- Electrification of community facilities through standalone solar systems and solar water pumps for communities; and
- Technical assistance, including institutional development, capacity building and project implementation support.
