ASSIGNMENT TITLE: Procurement of Consultancy Services for the Migration and Update of the Small Hydropower Atlas

I. Background

The Government of Kenya through the Ministry of Energy seeks to update the Small Hydropower Atlas. An initial study involved resource assessment in all the river drainage systems in the country and establishment of a Geographic Information System (GIS).

The tasks to be undertaken are as follows:

1. Convert the geodatabase to an Open Source GIS System that is stable, customizable with relevant plugins, well documented and supported.
2. Capture data and update the platform to reflect the current hydropower developments in the country.
3. Train the users on the application of the Open Source GIS System as well as demonstrate field data collection/verification process and consequently the update of the database.
4. The Atlas to be available online for public, while all the source GIS map projects files be in the custody of the client.

The Kenya Ministry of Energy now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- i. The relevance of the core business of the firm to the envisaged specialized assignment;
- ii. The firm’s general and specific experience including similarity and nature of assignments successfully delivered;
- iii. The firm's overall organizational competence, capability and qualifications as demonstrated through its overall technical experts' size and mix, financial, technical and managerial strengths and good will in the industry;

- iv. Earlier client reference, reputation and goodwill the firm has in the sector;
- v. Key experts' biodata is not required and will not be evaluated at this stage.

II. Terms of Reference:

III. Selection Method:

Firms will be selected in accordance with the Quality Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method, following shortlisting, as set out in the Procurement Regulations.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications.
