1.0 Introduction

The Government of Kenya received financing from the World Bank towards the financing of the Kenya Off-Grid Solar Access Project for underserved counties (K-OSAP). The project covers a period of six years. The project development objective is to increase access to modern energy services in underserved counties of Kenya. The project is being implemented in 14 counties, namely:- Garissa, Isiolo, Kilifi, Kwale, Lamu, Mandera, Marsabit, Narok, Samburu, Taita Taveta, Tana River, Turkana, Wajir and West Pokot. The Project is being implemented by the Ministry of Energy, Kenya Power and Lighting Company (KPLC) and Rural Electrification Authority (REA).

2.0 Project Components

The Project comprises the following components:

- Electrification of households, public facilities and businesses through mini-grid systems;
- Electrification of households through standalone solar systems and provision of clean cooking solutions for house-holds;
- Electrification of community facilities through standalone solar systems and solar water pumps for communities; and
- Technical assistance, including institutional development, capacity building and project implementation support.
